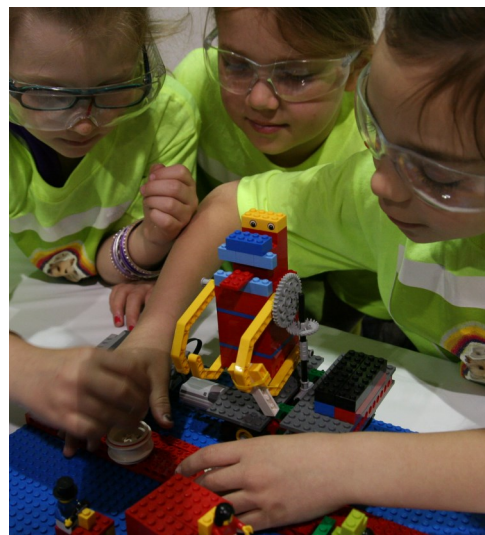




2019-2020 Grants for New Ontario School Packs

Thank you for your interest in starting a new FIRST LEGO League Jr. School-Pack in Ontario for the 2019-2020 “Boomtown Build” season. A limited number of grants are available, so do not delay applying.

Step 1

Register and pay for your School Pack (\$995 + Shipping/Handling USD <https://my.firstinspires.org/Dashboard/>)

Step 2

Fill out application at <https://www.firstroboticscanada.org/flljrschoolpack/grant/>

If your grant is approved, a cheque will be made payable to the school/ company/organization on your application and mailed the to address provided. Grants can not be made payable to an individual. 2019-2020 grants are \$3,250 CAD for each new School Pack to a maximum of five per school/ organization. This grant only applies to School Packs and is not for single teams or Class packs.

Note:

This grant is to be used to create a new School Packs. Organizers must commit to the program for a minimum of three years and host an Expo for their teams. If your organization has had grant funding for fewer than five teams in the previous seasons you may apply for grants to start more teams, up to a total of 5. Additional teams are welcome but do not qualify for this grant. Teams must be part of a school, recognized company or community group such as homeschool group, library, club, etc.
