Thank you for your interest in starting a <u>new</u> FIRST LEGO League Jr. School-Pack in Ontario for the 2019-2020 "Boomtown Build" season. A limited number of grants are available, so do not delay applying.

Step 1

Register and pay for your School Pack (\$995 + Shipping/Handling USD https://my.firstinspires.org/Dashboard/

Step 2

Fill out application at https://www.firstroboticscanada.org/flljrschoolpack/grant/

If your grant is approved, a cheque will be made payable to the school/company/organization on your application and mailed the to address provided. Grants can not be made payable to an individual. 2019-2020 grants are \$3,250 CAD for each new School Pack to a maximum of five per school/organization. This grant only applies to School Packs and is not for single teams or Class packs.

Note:

This grant is to be used to <u>create a new School Packs</u>. <u>Organizers must commit to the program for a minimum of three years and host an Expo for their teams</u>. If your organization has had grant funding for fewer than five teams in the previous seasons you may apply for grants to start more teams, up to a total of 5. Additional teams are welcome but do not qualify for this grant. Teams must be part of a school, recognized company or community group such as homeschool group, library, club, etc.

Required Commitment
